INTRODUCTION


Steigers Compliance Management System (CMS) is a powerful compliance management tool that has been specifically designed to support facilities that operate under the Title V Air Quality Permit Program. The development of CMS and its Air Quality Module arose from Steigers' knowledge and experience with regulatory permitting requirements and the need to support compliance managers with demanding reporting requirements under Title V. This product was developed within the Microsoft Access™ relational database application and is extremely user-friendly. It is specifically intended to support owner/operators of utility or industrial facilities and promotes achieving timely and accurate reporting obligations required by various regulatory permits. The product creates a uniform reporting infrastructure that streamlines data collection, management of compliance obligations, and reporting both from a regulatory and facility management perspective. 

FEATURES

Login and password protected security access

- Different corporate and user level access available
- Provides an audit trail for all system transactions, tagging each with date, time, and user ID
- Supports multiple facilities in a single application with facility specific configuration
 - Corporate users can monitor reports and operations across multiple facilities
 - Stores facility contact information and emission source specifications
 - Supports dual/multiple fuel-fired emission sources
 - Supports post-combustion control devices like SCR, baghouses, and electrostatic precipitators
 - Maintains records of each individual emission source's fuel use, operation hours, and energy production data
 - Performs data validation checks
 - Prepares regulatory and management reports for various operating parameters
 - Calculates emissions for regulated air pollutants and 12-month rolling totals
- Provides user-friendly wizard to create semi-annual facility operating reports (FOR)
 - Greatly streamlines creation of FORs
 - After a FOR is finalized, supporting data can be locked to prevent unauthorized revisions
 - Readily adapted for other regulatory reports
- Document management feature allows user to electronically store key compliance documents in pdf format:
 - Visible emission observations (VEO)
 - Fugitive dust observations
 - Fuel delivery invoices
 - Fuel blending logs and analyses
- Provides notification alerts of impending reporting obligations and other compliance tasks
- Provides an email communication link for a user to interact with corporate system administrators
- Can be deployed on a wide range of platforms from individual desktop/laptop computers and office LANs to geographically-dispersed corporate networks
- Structured to readily support other functional modules such as equipment maintenance, forecasting, water quality/discharge, hazardous waste management, etc. 

SERVICES

The CMS team performs standard configuration requirements to optimize the product to support your facility. The configuration requirements includes entry of the facility's current stationary sources and makes provisions to readily update stationary source inventories. The facility's source-specific emission factors and ratings are configured to support calculation for reporting the facility emissions. Training and product manuals are provided for the selected users. The CMS team provides help line support telephonically and by email. Maintenance and support of the CMS solutions package is provided for the first year, and thereafter by maintenance agreement.
